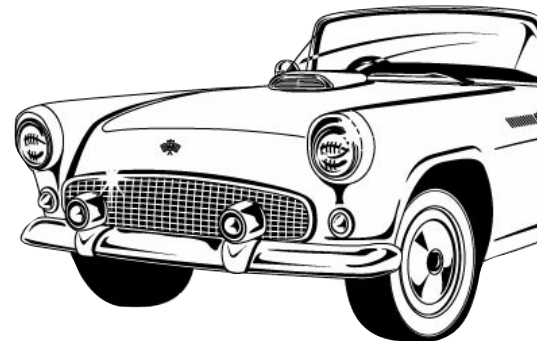

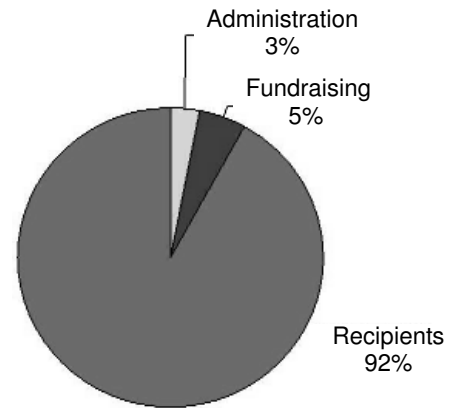
Mission Statement
